

WITC content

Level 1: Bible handling class (First Year)

We train students how to extract and deliver gospel messages from different Bible genres by working through some key books in each genre.

Term 1: January- March:

Foundational topical classes: Authority of Scriptures, Bible Overview and Gospel Frames.

Term 2: April –June:

- New Testament letters: Ephesians
- Old Testament Narratives: Exodus

Term 3: July- September:

- Gospels: Matthew
- Old Testament Prophecy: Isaiah

Term 4: July- November:

- Psalms and Wisdom Literature
- Apocalyptic Literature: Revelation

Level 2: Field Training (Second year)

Mentoring students in their real life ministry assignments whether in church, Christian organization, work place, small groups, family, etc.

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

What is WITC?

'Follow me, I will make you fishers of Men (Mt.4:15). This was the penetrating command and promise that Jesus gave to his very first couple of disciples.

And Paul addressed Timothy as he passed on to him the mantle of the great gospel deposit *'Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth (2 Tim.2:15).'*"

This need of 'approved workers' is more critical today than ever in the Church. And the Lord is still giving this invitation to anyone who would, to come after him and be 'made' by the means of his word into an instrument to fulfill his purpose for and through His church.

WITC is simply a training program that seeks to contribute to meet this need.

How WITC differs from Theological College?

We don't attempt to give an academic grounding in theological subjects like biblical languages, church history, or systematic doctrine, important as these are. Rather, we aim to give thorough grasp of the Gospel in the whole Bible and the basic principles of Bible Exposition according to the different bible genres.

WITC's expected outcomes

The overall aim of the course is to shape students for gospel/kingdom impact in different contours of their lives and ministries. Specifically, students should expect:

- To be equipped to study on their own, or extract and pass on the gospel message in different bible books.
- To be equipped to deliver their work, and handle his relationships on biblical basis and for the cause of the Kingdom of God
- To be equipped for Bible exposition in key word ministries like Pulpit Preaching, children ministry, small group or One to One ministry, etc. in the context of Rwanda.
- To be challenged to open their lives to the Lord and to one another for an honest life that reflects the gospel truths they are digging from Scripture. To this end they will benefit from relational discipleship from the teachers on individual basis.

Who is WITC for?

To be enrolled in WITC you must:

- Be a born again Christian, committed to a life of daily pursuit of godliness
- Be a regular member of a recognized church.
- Believe the Bible as the authority to govern all aspects of the believer's life and of the church
- Be willing to be involved in a specific ministry in the church or engage your profession as ministry
- be able to follow teaching and express yourself in English

What is the WITC schedule?

WITC will run two main tracks of activities:

- Weekend classes: from Friday 17h30 to 21h00 and Saturday 8h30 to 13h00 These will be 2 weekends only each month, generally the 2nd and 3rd weekend of the month.
- Mid-week activities will include: men and women bible studies to be equipped with skills to lead and run small groups.

What is the WITC cost?

WITC is free! Students are only encouraged to generously give to the work of WIM now and in the future as the Lord leads them. The only felt cost is TIME!
